		Connect to God's story
		Read Romans 6:1-4. How does Paul describe what happens when we are baptized? As we follow Jesus, what glorious and supernatural power is displayed?
		How does this passage help us celebrate fully with our brothers and sisters who are being baptized?

Sometimes something as wonderful as Jesus' supernatural victory over sin and death that we celebrate at Easter, through the Lord's Table and Baptism can be difficult to believe. How do you understand the difference between doubt and unbelief? What do you do in times of doubt? How can you keep doubt from sliding into unbelief?

Read Mark 9:14-29.

What is the struggle facing this boy's father? What struggle are the disciples facing? Have you prayed something similar to: "I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!"?

Who's power is at work in this story? *Re-read verse 29.* Why is this verse important to answering this question?

Read Ephesians 1:3-8.

Make a list below of the things that are true found in this passage of our relationship with Jesus as we follow Him:

Have you experienced any of these in your own life? If so, in what way?

Take some time to thank God for the life-changing work of His Spirit that we experienced together on Sunday. Ask Him to reveal to you the next step He would like you to take with Him on the journey.
