What is the mind?

The human mind can be defined as the element in an individual that feels, perceives, thinks, and especially reasons and wills.

Getting Your Attention Engaging the Mind. (Deuteronomy 6)

- Vs 1: Teach to observe – generational impact.
- Vs 2: Fear the Lord.
- Vs 3: Hear O Israel, be careful to observe – consequences of disobedience.
- Vs 4: Hear O Israel.
- Vs 5: Love the Lord – An activity of the mind that manifests itself in multiple ways.
- Vs 6: The Lord commands are to be upon your hearts.
- Vs 7: Impress them upon your children.
- Vs 7: Talk to them when you sit, when you walk, when you lie down, when you get up. Have the word on your mind and present it to your children's mind constantly.
- Vs 8: Tie them as symbols on your hands; bind them on your foreheads.
- Vs 9: Write them on your doorframes.
