The Great Question: Who am I?

Our identity wrongly comes from...

- what we've accomplished.
- what we have.
- what people think of us.

A lie believed as truth will affect you as if it were true.

A lie believed vandalizes my soul.

To Break The Lie:

- Confession
- Repentance
- Obedience

How do I walk out my true identity?

I walk with Jesus.

- Listening to him.
- Doing what he does.
- Doing what he says – obeying.

I declare the truth.

- I have boldness and confident access to God through faith in Christ. - Ephesians 3:12
- The peace of God guards my heart and mind. - Philippians 4:7
- God supplies all my needs. - Philippians 4:19
- I have been made complete in Christ. - Colossians 2:9-10
- I have been raised up with Christ. - Colossians 3:1
- God loves me and has chosen me. - 1 Thessalonians 1:4
