Why we like to add to what God says:

- Working on the outside gives us control... Working on the inside requires change.
- The Pharisees turned helpful spiritual *tools* into rigid religious *rules*.
- God doesn't want our religion He wants a relationship.

Frivolous Rules	Fundamental Principles
Outward Piety	True Inward Holiness
Neglect replaces the Word of God	Exalts the Word of God.

Re-read Mark 7:6-13.

What specific complaints did Jesus raise against the Pharisees' approach to tradition?

What sorts of traditions do we observe today that get in the way of really honoring God?

Re-read Mark 7:14-23.

How does Jesus' view of becoming "unclean" differ from that of the

Pharisees?

In what ways do we sometimes emphasize appearance over internal reality?

Why is the condition of our heart so important to our actions?

Read Psalm 51:10. How can you have a clean heart?
