Looking back over what Jeff talked about on Sunday, was there something you'd like to share?

What is your favorite gift you received when you were little? Now that you're older, what kind of gifts do you like to receive and how has that changed?

What can be challenging about gifts we receive? Can you think of anything that can be challenging about the Holy Spirit's gifts he gives?

### Connect to God's story

Read Ephesians 4:11-12 and Romans 12:6-8.

Are any of these gifts of the Holy Spirit something you recognize God has given you and wants you to grow with him in as part of your journey?

What are ways you can recognize when God has given you a spiritual gift? What role do you think Life Groups can have in seeing your gifting?

Read Acts 6:1-7.

What gifts do you see used in this passage? What was the result of partnering with the Holy Spirit in the church using the various gifts different people had? Were there any gifts that surprise you? Why?

Read 1 Peter 4:10-11.

What is the purpose of the various gifts God gives us? God has a great variety of spiritual gifts... do you believe he has given you one (or more?) What makes it hard for us to believe a gift may be for you?

What does it mean to be a good steward of the gifts you've been given? To use those gifts well?

How does using our gifts bring glory to God? In what ways have you seen this in your walk with the Lord?

*Take some time to talk to the Lord about what gifts he wants to help you grow and discover as you walk with him. Ask him to show you what he would like to do in and through you as we learn how to serve the Lord and the people he has connected us with.*

## **THE PURPOSE OF LIFE GROUPS**

*Life Groups exist to promote spiritual maturity and personal growth through meaningful relationships with Jesus and each other through the study of God's Word (Romans 8:29 & Hebrews 10:24-25).*

Here's how we accomplish this in our community throughout the week:

### **SHARE**

Each week we'll take time to share what is happening in our lives. At first this sharing will include planned "sharing questions." But after the first few weeks, it will become more informal and personal as we feel more comfortable.

### **STUDY**

Each week we'll study a section from God's Word that relates to the previous weekend's sermon or an appropriate personal growth topic. Our goal is to learn how to live out our Christianity in everyday life by following Jesus.

### **SUPPORT**

Each week we'll learn how to take care of one another as Christ commanded (John 15:9-13). This care can take many forms such as prayer, encouragement, listening, challenging one another and meeting real needs.

### **SERVE**

Spiritual growth is fostered not only by what we gain through the support and input of others, but also through service to others. The role each of us fills is important to the health of the church and for us to be the hands and feet of Jesus to the community in which we live (Ephesians 4:11-16).

Throughout the Life Group session, it is our hope that you can find and/or be affirmed in the ways the Father has designed you to serve and make a difference in His kingdom as He conforms you to the image of His Son! (Romans 8:28-30)
