Two questions to ask the Holy Spirit:

The Trinity is a beautiful mystery.

When we look at the Trinity, we have to understand our limitations:

- We are limited by our humanity. (Isaiah 55:8-9)
- We are limited by our language. (1 Corinthians 13:11-12)
- We don't have to understand something completely to experience it.

The Trinity consists of three persons:

- The Father (John 1:1-2; Isaiah 45:18-23; John 3:16)
- The Son (John 14:26; Matthew 3:17)
- The Spirit (1 Peter 1:1-2; Genesis 1:1-2)
